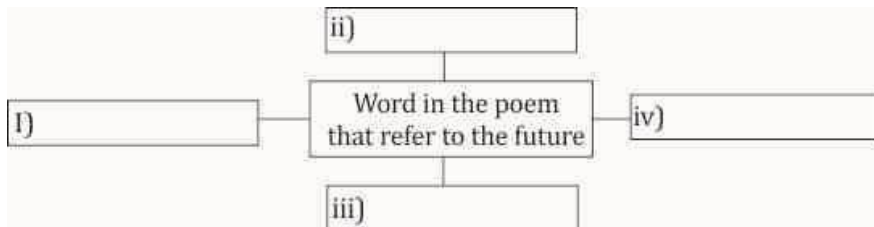

There are three types of Gastro-intestinal disorders: Diarrhea, Cholera and Typhoid although they all affect the intestines, they are caused by different bacteria.

Diarrhea is caused by Rota viruses, the symptoms for which are extreme dehydration electrolyte imbalance and muscle cramps.

Cholera is caused by water-borne bacteria called Vibrio Cholera. The symptoms are a little more severe than Diarrhea. Extreme dehydration, dry and shriveled skin, low blood pressure and lethargy and are some of the symptoms.

Typhoid is an intestinal disorder caused by a bacterium called Salmonella Ulcers, fever and vague abdominal discomforts are the symptoms of Typhoid.
